

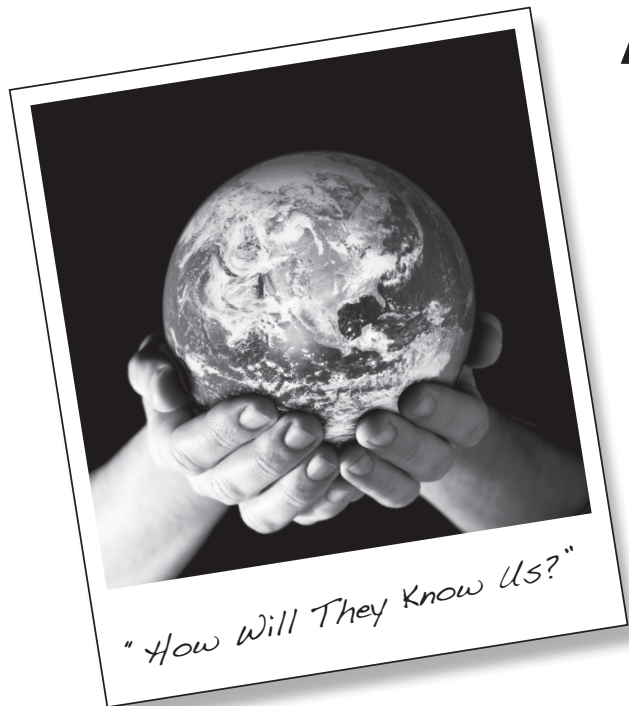

This mural will be included with thousands from around the world next year in Egypt in The Art Miles Mural Project Exhibit, celebrating the UNESCO Decade of Peace and Non-violence Among Children of the World, 2000-2010.

Guided by Claudia Lefko, Director of the Iraqi Childrens Art Exchange, artist Linda Iannacone, Professor Branda Miller and students of the “Art, Community, Technology” class at Rensselaer.
